Prepare yourself for the coolest onslaught of fun and fellowship you've had all summer!

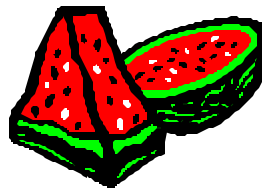

Brad Leali is Guest Artist This Sunday, July 9th

Brad Leali, alto saxophonist and TTU jazz professor, will be our first **July Guest Artist** featured this **Sunday, July 9th**, in both worship

services. Brad Leali has been referred to as one of the most important voices on the alto saxophone of this era. Having received his music education degree from the University of North Texas, in which he performed and recorded with the world renowned One O'clock Lab Band, Brad went on to play lead alto saxophone with the Harry Connick, Jr. Orchestra as well as being the musical director.

During this period, he relocated to New York City and established himself as a major voice in the highly competitive jazz community. After leaving Harry Connick, Jr. to join the Count Basie Orchestra, Brad, continued to enjoy success as the featured alto saxophone soloist.

Leali's philosophy on jazz is very simple and straight forward. "I want everyone to enjoy

jazz music – not just jazz musicians. I teach my students to play music, not just the notes, and in their search for creativity, to never forget their audience."
